In March, we had major setbacks in the ministry with breakdowns in a lot of our equipment. Our major editing equipment wouldn't work, so we couldn't record any video classes. Something happened to our streaming server and it wouldn't stream, which cut off our radio stations. It also stopped all our video going out over the Internet. On top of that a virus hit our internet sites. For about two months we were at a standstill with using high technology to get the Gospel out. Paul, Paulo Cesar, and I worked and worked trying to get everything back on line.

Mark Merrikin, a longtime friend in Sequim and Microsoft technician, was a life saver in respect to our equipment. From Sequim, with a program called Team Viewer, he was able to get into our computers and make the necessary changes from his own computer. He was able to repair our problems in our operating systems and get them working again. I am happy to announce that at this moment we have the equipment up and running. We now have most of the solutions to the problems we faced.

Video Growth

The video-internet ministry continues to grow once again and people are being introduced and indicating they are receiving the Lord into their heart and life. With our Bible Institute we are also putting it in a format that can be used over the cell phone which will save a lot of time in the long run. I think we will be OK until the end of the year.

- 5. For our families' health. At this time we are all fine, but at this time of the year health problems can occur. Due to the extreme temperature changes, like 74 degrees one day and 50 the next. It affects your health. There is also a major smog problem until September when the winds begin to blow again causing respiratory problems. The smog is so bad at times that the government closes the schools and tells the students to stay at home. (It is kind of like staying at home when it snows.) On certain days, the government restricts the use of 10% of the cars, and on extreme days up to 60%.
