Busy two months



Sally shared her testimony in Chile's Presidential chapel as Jim translated.

"As a high school forensic member pursuing music and drama, I was popular, but my childhood was a tragedy. I was molested by the grade school janitor almost every day of my life between the ages of 6 to 9 years old." "The school janitor was later arrested and the trial brought out that he had molested over 300 children in the elementray school."

"Sometime in your life, you have to deal with the shame and guilt. Keeping it a secret for years does as much damage as the molestation."

"After receiving Christ, my life took on a new purpose and I was able to forgive and love. Those who have been molested and have never spoken to any one, try to find someone and reach out for help."

Sally started to share her testimony publically for the first time soon after we were married. Since then, we have had many opportunities to pray and minister to those who have been victims.

One of Chile's most famous marathon runners who carried the Chilean flag in the opening ceremonies of the Olympics in Rio 2016, said in an interview just before she left for Brazil that her stepfather (a pastor) molested her from the time she was 5 until she was 18. Now 40, this was the first time she shared what happened to her. The revelation greatly impacted the country. Pray for those who have been molested around the world.
