These past few months have been very busy for us.

You have probably noticed we have a new address and a new mission for whom we work with. We worked with Son of Man's Mission for 19 years and the SOMM President, Russ Swank and the treasurer, Ardis Swank have just retired. As a result, the mission in late October, ceased their overseas ministry. All the

equipment and everything else related to us is in the process of being moved over to our new organization called Integrity Ministries, a non profit organization similar to Son of Man's Mission. We continue to do what we have always done for the last 30 years and that is reaching and building up people for the Lord through the use of media and the Internet. Integrity Ministries is a faith based mission and each missionary raises their own financial support.

We want to thank each and every one of you for your continued support, partnership and prayer in our work the Lord is doing through us in Chile and the Spanish speaking world. We are also glad to continue the work the Lord has called us to do and it is such a blessing to see your continued support.



COMIBAM

On December 7-10, Lina and I participated in a missionary conference called COMIBAM that included close to 1,000 delegates from Argentina, Chile, Paraguay and Uruguay. COMIBAM is dedicated to missions and started after the Lausanne conference in Europe. At the time, church leaders around the world sat together to analyze the Evangelical Church world-wide and COMIBAM was one of the results

of that meeting. For this year's COMIBAM event, I was asked to be on the executive committee and I also gave a seminar on "How to use technology in missions."

EVANGELISTIC OUTREACH

The first week of September I drove with some of our staff to Mendoza, Argentina, to videotape the South American international youth leadership congress sponsored by Youth Specialties. 2,800 enthusiastic young people from all over South America attended. Tony Campolo from Pennsylvania and Juan Carlos Ortiz from California spoke. We were prepared so it all turned out well. God really touched these youth leaders in many special ways and He will continue to work wonders in their lives as they take what they have learned and experienced back to their respective countries.

For two weeks in August and two weeks in October, Lina, traveled to the extreme north and south of Chile. She covered over 2000 miles, teaching and preaching in eight cities. She also was the only woman asked to join the Chile steering committee for the Billy Graham Association national Evangelistic outreach, *My Hope*. With only 50% of the churches reporting their impact at the time this letter went to print, over 55,000 decisions for Christ had been made through this outreach.

In October we had the pleasure of having a team from Brothers Keepers Ministries, Bellingham WA, come down and visit us. They remodeled the studio bathroom and wall-papered our family room. The team included Mike Glick, the leader, Dr. Richards Gardner, Steve and Chantel Gardner, Kerry Garrett, Molly Greenleaf and Aaron Twitchell. Dr. Gardner, a Dermatologist, also spent some time visiting a Children's home and a local Drug Rehab center. He kindly forwarded some products later on to some of the children he had seen at the Children's home.

Paul and I joined Steve in Mexico City to receive the award presented by the National Academy of Christian Music and Arts. We thank the Lord for this public recognition.
