New National Holiday for the Evangelical Church in Chile

After two years, the Chilean Congress voted unanimously to pass a bill that would introduce a national Protestant Holiday. Lina and I have been participating in ecclesiastical committees to help create public policy for the bill. The Chilean President invited us to be present when she signed the bill into law. I believe Chile is the first country in the world to have a national Evangelical Church holiday. The government recognized the work the church has done throughout the years in the process of changing the spiritual and moral fiber of the country.
