Reflections: Past and Present

My name is Waldemar Verdugal. Forty years ago, I walked into Alfa and Omega, a University Christian student meeting sponsored by Campus Crusade for Christ in Chile. The leaders of this group were Jim Thurston and his wife. They taught, trained, and counseled the students who came to the meetings about their relationship with Christ. This training has been with me for 40 years. Jim has been able to help me over the years, especially during the difficult times in my life. When I invited Christ into my life in 1969, it was a joy to work hand in hand with Jim and his wife. They always believed in me, and even to this day, he continues to minister in my life.

Pioneer Outreach

Accepting Christ, encouraged me to reach others for the Lord. I formed a drama group in Alfa and Omega that was very successful. This was a pioneer outreach, and the first time Christian drama was used outside the church to share the Gospel in Chile. The group that Jim led was a first to take Christ to the students of my generation. He raised a consciousness about the need to share Christ with others. This helped me to grow spiritually and strive for excellence.

Author of 28 books

Who knew at that time I would be the author of 28 books? Many are being pushed over the Internet through Amazon, and twelve were published in Mexico. While in the States, I was a Professor at the University of Southern California. My influence continues as I write for El Mercurio, the most important newspaper in Chile, and also articles for two Latin magazines; Caras and Vogue Magazine.

Mother Teresa

One of the most exciting times of my life was working for six months with Mother Teresa in Calcutta. Helping in a leper colony with her, impacted me forever. To see her working with people who were infected by highly contagious diseases, touching them with her hands without any fear, stimulated my faith in Christ.

While working in India, I became ill and was given a shot with a contaminated needle. Soon after, the Doctor diagnosed me with AIDS. Over ten years have gone by, and God continues to give me strength to write. As a writer, God has given me His energy to continue at a ripe old age of 62. I have had some extremely difficult problems in my life, but Jesus has helped me overcome them. I will serve Him until he calls me home.

This testimony was given to Sally and I in May 2015.

May 1, at 5:50 P.M. the Calbuco Volcano burst into life after decades of inactivity. It was the first time in 43 years. In eight days it erupted three times. This led the government to order the evacuation of 2,500 people. Calbuco is one of the most active volcanoes in Chile, having erupted in 1961 and 1972, and many times before that. The eruptions caused the cancellation of flights to and from Chile. It forced farmers in the area to evacuate their livestock.
