
Ministering in Bellingham Churches

Although only around 60 people attended, over 300 watched the service online. I spoke on "Listening to God's Voice."


A New Addition to Our Studio


National Group Meeting

His son Jon said Dave was in the hospital and not expected to make it, and he wanted us to come immediately. We immediately bought tickets, packed our suitcases, and arrived in Bellingham two days later.

Dave was conscious for the next four days and seemed to be improving. During the twelve hours each day over those four days, we revisited our seventy years of friendship, and it was wonderful. On the fifth day, we were surprised to find him unconscious. It wasn't long after that Dave woke up in heaven. Dave was my best friend and one of the last early supporters of our ministry. I had the privilege of doing Dave's funeral.

I met Dave in the 9th grade at our church. We were both in the same grade and the same age. We hung out in high school, at church, in our car club, and later in college, where we shared a room for the first two years. Dave was a musician, fisherman, hunter, Bible teacher, and businessman.



Just a few days after Dave went home to be with the Lord, another close friend, Judge Steve Alexander, joined him. Steve had been a friend for over 40 years and a long-time supporter of our ministry too. They will be dearly missed by everyone!
