Jim is the recipient of the National Meritorious Ministry Service Award given by the Chilean Government.







October 26, 2016, Jim received the National Meritorious Ministry Service Award given by the Chilean Congress. Each year, twenty-five ministers are recognized throughout the country.

The award is given to those who have had a long dynamic ministry, and who have positively influenced spiritually in the country. The President of the Senate, Ricardo Lagos Weber, presented the plaque to Jim. This was the first time a foreigner has received this distinction, Lina received this same award 3 years ago, and this is the first time a married couple has received it for their individual ministries.

In the first year of Jim's ministry in Chile there were two disciples trained, Lina and Luis Perez. Luis received this award about 7 years ago, Lina 3 years ago, and now Jim being recognized for his Christian leadership.
