Time with Chile's President

In September, the Evangelical Church invited the President of Chile to our yearly meeting, a significant event where the representatives of the Protestant Church gather in one of our large churches to pray for the Government and the Country. I was one of the twenty who sat on the platform as I have been for many years. We prayed, had music, and gave the Gospel. The President's response to the meeting was particularly noteworthy, please pray for him. He said to the press, "As I have said before, I do not have the gift of faith. But I feel the tremendous energy from those who do have faith. They transmitt this energy. In addition I feel tremendous vibes of support through their prayers."

Evangelistic Picnic

Our associate staff organized on October 12, an evangelistic picnic at the Word of Life picnic grounds with 580 participants. It was designed for Christians to bring their non-Christian friends so they may have a good time and hear the Gospel. There were 48 adults who received Christ as their Lord and Savior.

Meeting in the President's office

On October 30, the President of Chile invited 120 church leaders to his office to celebrate the National Evangelical Holiday, a day of great historical significance. Chile is among the few countries where businesses close their doors on this day, which marks the Reformation.

Sally and I, once again, had the honor of being invited to this unique event. Sitting under the warm sun and enjoying the music from the Salvation Army band, we listened to the President give thanks to all the churches for what they've done for Chile this past year.

Three-day youth conference

A three-day holiday at the end of October made it possible to have a youth conference, *Counter Culture*, where over 800 youth met to worship and praise the Lord. Since our house was close to the event, we had seven young people stay at our home. We filled up two empty bedrooms and put an additional three in our living room where they slept on air mattresses.

Many lives were changed at the conference and some are now praying about going full time into the ministry or to the mission field.
